Councillor Mrs. M. Perfect also shared concerns that when no public firework events, this increases private displays and causes a number of safety issues.

Councillor P. Cunningham agreed and proposed this matter is placed on the Finance and Policy Committee.

Councillor Mrs. N. Davies raised concerns about the number of firework displays held at Flint Mountain Park hotel, which cause disruption to both residents and pets and proposed we write to the hotel.

Councillor R. Davies said as a progressive Council, we need to consider the effects on wildlife and asked if any donation that the Council provide to firework displays, we should ask for a copy of their impact assessment.

Councillor Mrs. M. Perfect confirmed any Council events that have fireworks all have impact assessments.
